Using this Guide

The resources guide lists reports produced by official bodies, such as by the HM Chief Inspector of Prisons and the Children's Commissioner for England. All relevant ILPA publications and information sheets that are child-specific have also been included.

Finally, reports by NGOs and academic articles have been compiled and are presented on a thematic basis covering areas such as detention, trafficking, child poverty and mental health.

This resources guide is accurate as of April 2011. Law, policy and practice change over time, as do web links – full titles have been provided for all documents to make searching easier when a link no longer functions. Within each sub-section, organisations appear alphabetically and documents appear in reverse chronological order.

ILPA intends, by gathering all these resources together, to save busy practitioners time and to ensure that they are able to draw on a wide range of resources in their work. This guide can be downloaded and there is thus the possibility for the user to cut and paste particular extracts from the document cited into the body of the guide, or to add links of their own. It can also be used to develop an index to a file of hard copy resources if desired.
