### 1. The Application

The UK Border Agency and the British Embassy Manila, together with the Visa Application Centre, provide information to visa applicants about the types of documents they will be required to produce so that they can demonstrate to the Entry Clearance Officer that they meet the requirements of the Immigration Rules. The initial decision was made on the basis of the evidence the appellant had supplied. We advise applicants that the failure to submit such documentation may result in refusal of the application. The onus is on applicants to demonstrate that they meet the requirements of the relevant Rules. The Entry Clearance Officer carefully considered the application based on the appellant's passport, application form and documents that were provided. It was not necessary to interview the appellant in order to reach a decision.

The appellant had sought entry clearance as a Visitor. The Entry Clearance Officer (ECO) decided that the appellant had not met all the requirements of Paragraph 41 of the UK Immigration Rules for the reasons set out in the attached notice of refusal.

Following the refusal of the application, the refusal notice advised the appellant to submit any additional evidence they may have in order that the concerns mentioned in the notice could be properly addressed by this office.
